

Adoption Application Letter

Aggieland Humane Society's goal is to place pets in homes where they will be lifelong companions. Some dogs -due to potential size, breed, or personality- will be more challenging to care for and have an increased chance of being returned after adoption.

We feel the dog you have selected will be one of these more challenging pets. As part of the adoption process for this pet we ask that you write a letter providing more information regarding the following:

- Your lifestyle (i.e. student, working person, roommates or family members available to help, sedentary or active lifestyle, etc) and how much time will be devoted to the needs of the dog.
- Give us a description of what you expect the "day in the life of your dog" to be.
- · Crate training is recommended; clarify how it works and how you will use it.
- Specifically describe your pet exercise and mental stimulation plans.
