## **COMMUNITY SUPPORT REVENUE**

Many methods are utilized within the community to gather funds. These include direct mail requests, email promotions, unsolicited support, memorial and honorary gifts, grants from foundations, corporate sponsorships, donations from estates and life insurance, and donor-advised funds through the Brazos Valley Community Foundation. The community remains involved through peer-to-peer fundraising drives such as Bark Leaders and the Purrfect Pageant. Our Inspiring Tails Luncheon secures the long-term success of Aggieland Humane throughout the year and beyond.




## PROGRAM SERVICES REVENUE
