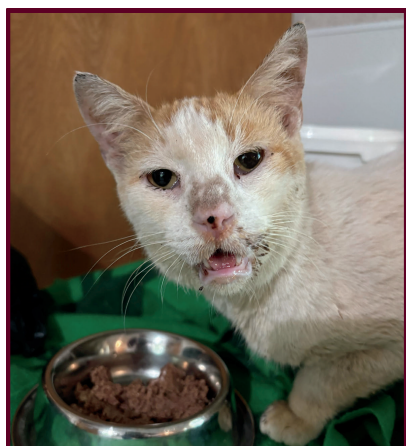
THE HEALING POWER OF YOU

Not every illness is hopeless; in fact, most are very treatable. The real danger is when contagious pets, often carrying illnesses in from the community, can spread disease to healthy ones in the shelter setting.

That's why the David Chapman Lifesaving Suite, generously donated in 2023, is so critical. **This suite has housed nearly 300 pets so far this year**, providing treatment and isolation for everything from the common cold to life-threatening diseases.



Because of you, at-risk pets are now healing and finding homes.

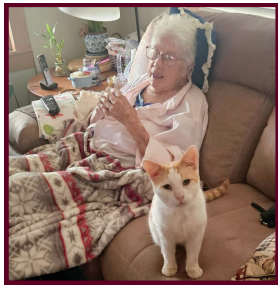


GUMBY'S ROAD TO RECOVERY

Gumby was found lifeless, face down in a kitchen sink. Years of neglect in a hoarding situation left a mark. The senior cat was weak and dirty, suffering from an upper respiratory infection and dental disease that made it painful for him to eat. Left untreated, he would have grown weaker by the day, **but you gave him a chance.**

At an off-site veterinarian, **all but four of Gumby's teeth were extracted to relieve pain.** Back at the shelter, staff made him a special "meat soup" to **hydrate and nourish his feeble body.** The team gave him soft blankets so he could finally feel the comfort and security he'd been missing.

YOU gave Gumby the medicine, surgeries, and TLC he needed to fight for his life.



In time, Gumby's strength returned and, after several baths, **he got his groove back!** How did we know Gumby was ready for his forever home? He would happily greet staff in the Chapman Suite and beg for snacks. Weeks later, **Gumby finally left with a loving family,** the happy ending he always deserved!

Gumby's survival is nothing short of a miracle. A miracle possible by you.

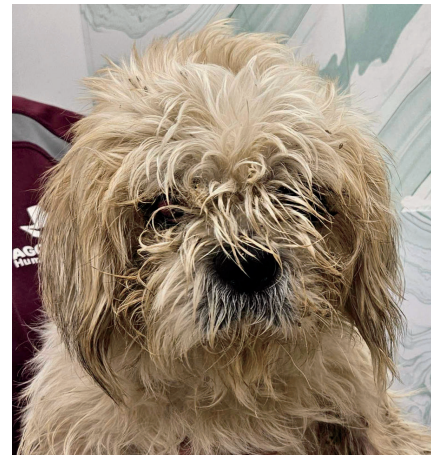
Ewok is just the first of many...
